IMPORTANT INFORMATION – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When must all fines be cleared? Yes, all fines must be cleared before you can pick up a cap and gown.

If a parent wants to pick up the cap/gown, the fines must be cleared first.

***When will caps and gowns be ready for distribution?** Pre ordered/paid for Caps and gowns will be distributed during lunch hour May 29th – 31th, (Wednesday – Friday) in the main foyer from 10:40 AM - 11:40 PM You must show photo ID. If you did NOT order a cap/gown, bring \$31.00 in cash or check made out to Lifetouch. You will be instructed at that time when you may come back to pick up your cap and gown.

What is the deadline for completing course work and submitting credits from other institutions that are required for graduation? ALL Cooper High School course work and credits earned while attending other schools must be submitted to guidance counselors no later than 3:30 PM on June 4th to ensure participation in commencement.

Is it true that students are eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony even if they are short one credit? Yes, students may participate in commencement if they are short one credit (one semester class) provided a credit completion plan has been established and is on record in the guidance office.

Do family members need tickets to attend commencement? Tickets are not required for outdoor stadium seating. However, each senior will receive SIX TICKETS during the commencement rehearsal. These tickets will be used to gain admittance to an indoor ceremony in the event of inclement weather. Regretfully, no additional tickets are available beyond the six tickets per student.

Can I attend the Senior All-Night Sendoff if I am not participating in the graduation ceremony? All seniors can attend the Senior All-Night Sendoff <http://2019cooperhssendoff.webs.com/> even if they do not attend CHS at the time or they do not graduate with their class.
